

Sir/Ma'am,

Government of India has emphasized on economic growth through infrastructure creation through its priority programmes of National Infrastructure Pipeline, National Monetization Pipeline and Gatishakti. Given that public spending in infrastructure is the key to unlocking and enhancing private investment, there is a thrust on Public-Private Partnership models across sectors.

2. Achievement of the end objectives of the infrastructure-driven flagship programmes is closely tied up to the quality of technical expertise and infrastructure-specific capacity among the officers of Center and States. The skill-set required range from understanding of different structuring models, varied legal & contractual frameworks to project appraisal and understanding of legal principles involved in contractual drafting and bidding processes.

3. With this context in sight, DEA has worked in collaboration with Capacity Building Commission (CBC) to frame a Capacity Enhancement Plan (CEP) for driving relevant learnings across Line Ministries, States and extended ecosystem in the country. While the larger plan and the training calendar for FY23 will be rolled out in the next financial year, for the last quarter of FY22, four trainings are proposed on different thematic areas regarding which an office memorandum has already been issued requesting for nominations (copy enclosed for ready reference).

4. For imparting CEP-specific training modules in Q4, two specific training programmes are designed with Indian School of Business (ISB), Hyderabad and Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Bangalore as training partners. The course flow for 5-day programme with ISB is centered on the themes of Project Ownership, Negotiations and Project Structuring, to be held in Delhi; and IIM-B on Capital Structuring decisions and Project Finance etc., to be held in Bangalore.

5. Given that ISB and IIM specific training programmes are going to be the first of the series of onsite trainings under this new capacity framework, you are requested to identify and nominate Group A officers (maximum of 4) preferably dealing with projects in Infrastructure sector (PPPs) who can benefit from these in-
