Powers and functions:

1. Officers entrusted with the sectors will route all the matter relating to EAPs through the Nodal Officer. The officers concerned will entrust other officials working with his/her group as per the overall work allotment order of PC Division time to time. In the absence of Nodal Officer all matters will be routed through Coordinator.
2. The Nodal Officer will route the matters through the Director (PC) for approval appraisal to the Secretary/ Principal Secretary/ Additional Chief Secretary, T&D Department. In the absence of the Director(PC) the Nodal Officer will route the matter through the Coordinator.
3. The Nodal Officer is empowered to mark or endorse any matter relating to EAPs to the concerned officer of Finance Department and the LEAP Cell for views and comments as and when required.
4. The Nodal Officer will also apprise the EAP related matter to the Coordinator and the Coordinator will also gather information from time to time for coordination and guidance.
5. All officers of the cell are empowered to carry out physical verification and monitoring of the projects under the sector (s) entrusted to them as and when required with intimation to the Director (PC).
6. The Cell is also empowered to take up meetings on the projects with the concerned agencies/PMUs of EAPs as and when required.
